Mr Abu Bakar graduated with a Master of Business Administration in 2013 from Singapore Management University.

He is the Managing Director (Gas & Specialized Vessels), Keppel Offshore & Marine Ltd and Keppel Singmarine Pte Ltd. He began his career in the Safety department and held various appointments in the Operations and Commercial departments at Keppel. In 2011, he was the CEO of Nakilat-Keppel Offshore & Marine Ltd (N-KOM), a joint-venture between Qatargas Transport Company and Keppel.

Mr Abu Bakar sits on various boards in Keppel Group companies and associates, notably Keppel Fels, Keppel Singmarine Pte Ltd, Keppel Shipyard Limited, Keppel Nantong Shipyard Co Ltd., Keppel Nantong Heavy Industry Co Ltd, Arab Heavy Industries PJSC, Nakilat Keppel Offshore & Marine Ltd, Baku Shipyard LLC, Keppel Singmarine Brasil Ltda, Maju Maritime Pte Ltd, Keppel Smit Towage Pte Ltd, FueLNG Pte Ltd, Bintan Offshore Fabricators Pte Ltd, and KS Investments Pte Ltd.

In addition, at the industry/ national level, Mr Abu Bakar sits on Bureau Veritas South East Asia Technical Committee, Workplace Safety and Health Council, Board of Trustees of the Singapore Institute of Technology, Board of PUB, Singapore's National Water Agency, Singapore Maritime Foundation and SMRT Corporation Ltd. He is also President of the Association of Singapore Marine Industries.

Mr Abu Bakar also served in various committees for the Ministry of Defence. He was a Member of the Advisory Council on Community Relations in Defence, Reward and Recognition Committee for Defence and was a Member of the SAFRA Management Committee where he chaired various SAFRA Clubs as Chairman and Vice-Chairman. At present, he is the Chief of Staff of HQ2 PDF Comd, holding the rank of Colonel (National Service) in the Singapore Armed Forces (SAF). He also served as the Singapore President's Honorary Aide-de-Camp to both Mr. Ong Teng Cheong and Mr. Nathan during their tenure as the President of Singapore. Mr Abu Bakar also sits on the Pro-Enterprise Panel, Ministry of Trade and Industry, since January 2019.

In recognition of his contributions to the SAF and community, he received various long and good service medals including the Formation NSmen of the Year award in 1998 and the SAF NSmen of the Year award in 1999. He was also awarded the Commendation Medal (Military) in 2002, the Public Service Medal (Pingat Bakti Masyarakat) in 2009, and the Public Administration Medal Bronze (Military) in 2015. In October 2017, Mr Abu Bakar received the Berita Harian Achiever of the Year Award in recognition of his outstanding achievement in the Community. He was also

appointed as Chairman for Tampines Central Citizens Consultative Community and M3@Tampines in 2018.
