6 Basic Workplace Safety and Health (WSH) Rules for Safe Operation of Excavator

An unsafe work condition or the unsafe behaviour of a worker during excavator work can lead to serious injuries or even death. Engage trained operators for excavator work, do your own risk assessment, and adopt the following safety practices before starting work.

Report to your supervisor if you feel unwell.



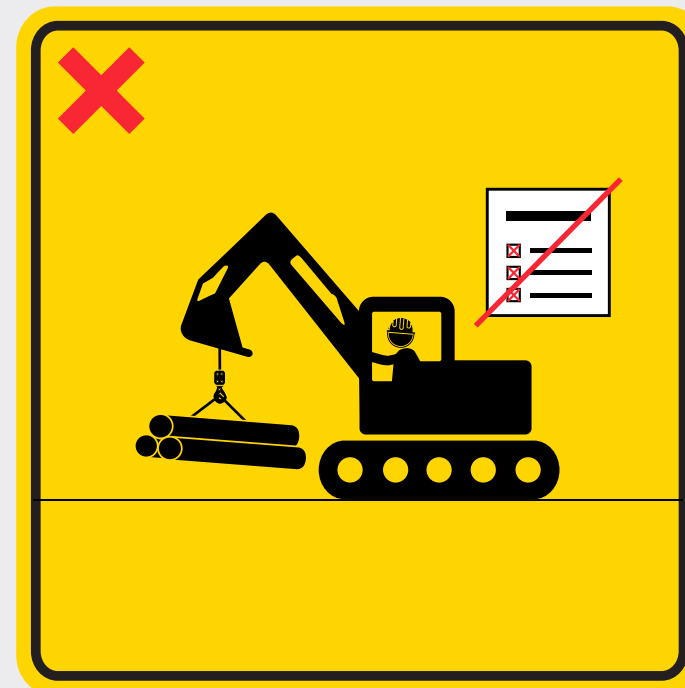
Operate an excavator only if you are competent and authorised.



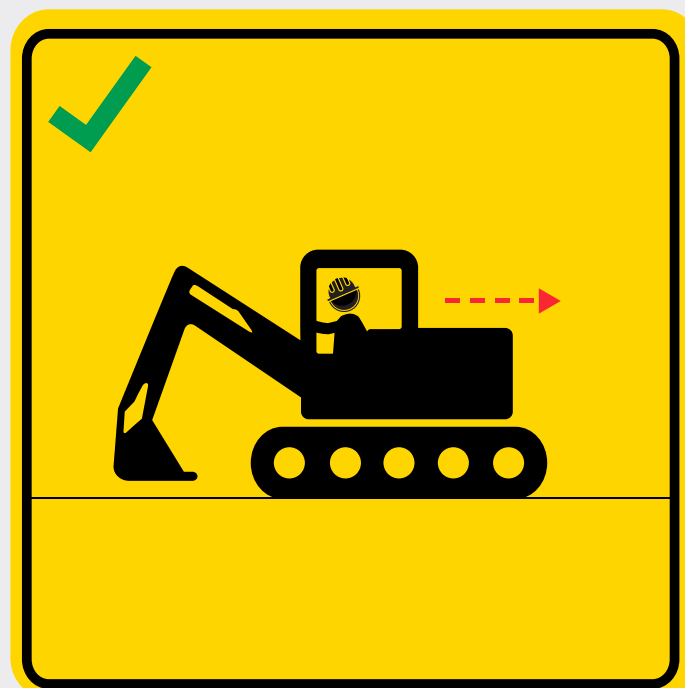
Inspect the excavator and the surrounding for abnormalities before use.



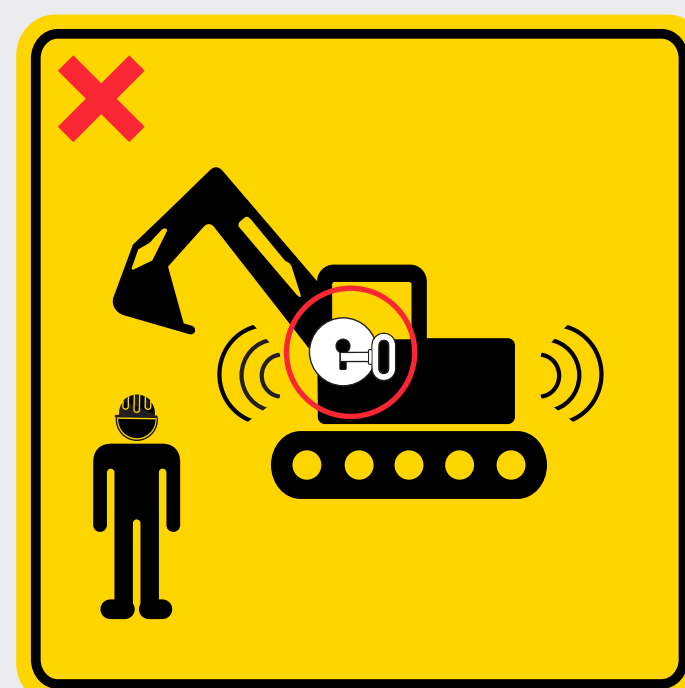
Do not use the excavator for lifting if it is not a certified lifting machine.



Check blind spots when operating the excavator.



Switch off the excavator and remove the key before leaving cabin.



Always refer to the manufacturer's manual for the specific excavator model before starting work.
