STAS-WSH Council webinar highlights safe works at height in the building specialist trade

On 12 July 2021, the Specialist Trade Alliance of Singapore (STAS) organised the first STAS-WSH Council Webinar to raise workplace safety and health (WSH) awareness amongst specialist trade contractors in Singapore. Themed "Safer Work At Height Post-COVID-19", the webinar highlighted the importance of WSH when performing works at height, and shared the technologies and practices to ensure a safe return to work amidst COVID-19.

Two speakers from the Ministry of Manpower's OSH Inspectorate and WSH Institute shared insights and case studies on working safely at height with ladders and technologies that the construction industry could adopt to improve WSH. The webinar rounded up with a presentation from HSC Pipeline Engineering Pte Ltd on its digital transformation journey to adopt the electronic Permit-To-Work system which helped it achieve better WSH outcomes and improve productivity for the organisation.
