Dr Eugene Fidelis Soh is CEO of Tan Tock Seng Hospital (TTSH) and Central Health. With 1,700 beds, TTSH serves the 1.4 million population in Central Singapore, in partnership with patients, primary care and community providers. TTSH is the flagship hospital of the National Healthcare Group (Singapore), an AON Hewitt Best Employer (Singapore) 2013 & 2015, and Hay's Employer of Choice at the HR Management Asia Awards 2018.

Dr Soh is a medical doctor by training with a Masters of Public Health (Healthcare Management) from Harvard University and an alumni of the Senior Executive Programme at the London Business School. Dr Soh holds the appointment of Adjunct Professor at the Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine; a partnership between Nanyang Technological University, Singapore and Imperial College London, UK.

In 2010, Dr Soh led the development and launch of Singapore's first integrated master plan for a new medical hub – HealthCity Novena Master Plan 2030. The Master Plan will see 9 new developments in Novena, which include a 300-bed National Centre for Infectious Diseases, a 600-bed rehabilitation hub, and a medical school.

Dr Soh is the Chairman for the Centre for Healthcare Innovation (CHI) Co-Learning Network established in 2016. The network comprises local and international partners from across healthcare institutions, agencies, academia and industry. CHI drives thought leadership in Systems Innovation, Workforce Transformation and Learning Andragogies. CHI's purpose-built 9-storey innovation building – the Ng Teng Fong Centre for Healthcare Innovation opened its doors in late 2018.

Dr Soh leads the Leadership & Organisational Development for the National Healthcare Group. His role is to build collective leadership and empower organisational health in order to support the large-scale transformation of healthcare towards NHG's vision of Adding Years of Healthy Life.
