He returned to Singapore in 2017 and became the Operations General Manager responsible for operations of the Chevron Oronite Singapore Manufacturing Plant.

He was named General Manager of Manufacturing & Supply in November 2019. In addition to being the General Manager of Manufacturing & Supply, Keng Yang is also the Director of Chevron Oronite Pte Ltd. He has responsibilities for Manufacturing and Supply activities in Asia Pacific.
