What is Vision Zero and what does it mean to the healthcare industry?

Vision Zero is a movement to inculcate a mindset that all injuries and ill-health at work are preventable, and a belief that zero harm is possible.

The healthcare industry has adopted the tagline, "Caring for the Well-being, Safety and Health (WSH) of our Healthcare Workers" as part of our VZ pledge. We believe that with care, zero harm to our staff and stakeholders is possible and all workplace-related injuries and ill-health are preventable. By caring for our healthcare workers and staff, we can uphold our responsibility to care for our patients and the community safely and healthily.

What does it mean to pledge for VZ?
