WSH Awards for Supervisors Application Guidelines

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About WSH Awards for Supervisors

This award recognises supervisors who take care of their workers by improving the safety and health performance in their workplaces.

Criteria

The criteria below represent the minimum conditions required to qualify. Fulfilling them does not mean the applicant will be awarded. The Award Panel will select the winners by assessing which applicants best fulfil the criteria. In addition, the Award Panel reserves the right to confer one Award to companies with multiple but identical applications, unless outcomes or achievements cited vary.

The nominated supervisor must meet the following conditions:

- Either a Singaporean/ PR/ S Pass/ Work Permit holder
- Worked at least two years in the company as a supervisor
- Performed a junior supervisory role instead of managerial role
- Oversaw a team of at least five workers

Qualifying period: 1 January 2022 to 31 December 2022

- No accident that has caused death or permanent disablement to workers under his/ her care
- 2. No breach¹ in workplace safety and health matters in the company under his/ her charge

Supervisors whom employers are nominating must have:

- 3. Illustrated the commitments to show that he/ she:
 - Takes care of workers
 - Contributes to improving the company's WSH performance
 - Has been active in the support for migrant welfare
- 4. Attended at least one WSH course at the supervisor level

Note: If you are nominating more than one supervisor, please submit separate applications for each of them. If the nominated supervisor is a registered WSH Officer, please advise them to apply for WSH Officer Awards instead.

¹ Includes Stop Work Order, Business Under Surveillance Programme, more than two compound fines (or fines exceeding \$2,000) including health-related offences from MOM Occupational Safety and Health Division, demerit points and WSH-related investigations, conviction or prosecution (including pending cases) with regard to workplace and labour matters under the Workplace Safety and Health Act and Employment Act. Excludes COVID-19 related matters.

Evaluation

The following associations will first evaluate their respective industry-specific applications:

- Association of Singapore Marine Industries (ASMI)*
- Singapore Logistics Association (SLA)
- Singapore Manufacturing Federation (SMF)
- The Singapore Contractors Associations Ltd (SCAL)

All other applications will be evaluated by the WSH Council.

*For marine industry, please submit the application to Association of Singapore Marine Industries (ASMI).

Interview session

Shortlisted supervisors will be required to attend an interview by a panel of judges held for each industry association.

Nomination by associations

A maximum of three winning supervisors from each association will be nominated for further evaluation to receive the WSH Award on a national platform.

Disqualification before announcement of results

An application may be disqualified if a <u>workplace accident</u> with any of the following consequences occurs before the announcement of results:

- Fatal accident
- Major injury accident
- Dangerous Occurrence (DO)

An application may also be disqualified if it contains inaccurate, false or misleading supporting documents, records or data, or if there is adverse reporting in the media pertaining to the applicant's or nominating company's workplace safety and health performance.

An applicant who withdraws or amends its <u>WSH Incident Report</u> and/ or an ongoing work injury claim during the period of application may be disqualified. An investigation will be conducted before the application can continue to be considered.

- 1. How did the supervisor encourage the workers in taking ownership of their safety and health? Cite at least one approach in strengthening ownership.
- 2. How did the supervisor ensure that the workers work in a safe and healthy environment? Cite at least one example where the supervisor identified health and safety risks in the workplace and recommended interventions to address the risks.
- 3. How did the supervisor communicate safety and health messages to the workers? Cite at least one example to show the supervisor's good working relationship with workers, where the workers feel comfortable enough to discuss safety and health issues with the supervisor.
- 4. Describe how the supervisor encourages good safety behaviour at the workplace. Cite at least one example where the supervisor rewards his/ her workers for good safety behaviour.

Commitment to improve the company's WSH performance

- Describe the supervisor's contribution in improving the company's WSH
 performance. Cite the initiative(s) that the supervisor proposed during the qualifying
 period and at least one initiative that was successfully implemented. Elaborate about
 the results achieved due to the initiative (e.g., number of workers benefitted from the
 initiative).
- 6. Share the supervisor's achievements during each of the past three years (2022, 2021 and 2020).

7. Tell us why the supervisor should be selected for this award. Cite the supervisor's achievements/ contributions in supporting the workers' welfare which go beyond his/ her scope of work and responsibilities, legislative requirements and/or company's WSH policies.
