About the WSH Tech Awards

This Award recognises bizSAFE Enterprises that have implemented effective technology to improve their safety and health standards in their workplaces. Under this award, small and medium enterprises (SMEs) are recognised for the successful adoption and integration of externally sourced WSH technologies that have led to significant improvements in workplace safety and health standards.

Criteria

The criteria below represent the minimum conditions required to qualify for the award. Fulfilling them will not automatically equate to the applicant being awarded.

The Award Panel will select the award recipients based on the ranked WSH performance and achievements, and all decisions are final. In addition, the Award Panel reserves the right to confer one award to companies with multiple but identical applications, unless outcomes or achievements cited vary.

Qualifying period: 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2025

Eligibility Criteria

1. No fatal or major injury resulting from a [work-related accident](#) in any worksites.
2. Not in the [Business Under Surveillance \(BUS\) programme](#) during the qualifying period.
3. No Dangerous Occurrence case during the qualifying period.
4. No [Stop Work Order](#) during the qualifying period.
5. No blacklist record, pending investigation, conviction or prosecution in court by the Ministry of Manpower
6. The implemented WSH technology must be at least under one of the following categories:
 - Robotics or drone-based solutions
 - Video analytics
 - Wearables
 - Sensors
 - Vehicular safety
 - WSH management applications
 - Heat stress prevention
7. Applicant must have implemented WSH technology to mitigate one WSH risk/ issue.

8. The WSH technology must have been implemented for at least six months with no reported accidents resulting from the implementation of the technology.
9. The WSH technology implemented must not have created or led to new risks.
10. The WSH technology must have been procured from a third-party tech-solution provider.
11. Applicant must be an SME¹.
12. Applicant must not be a WSH Service Provider.
13. Applicant must have at least attained bizSAFE Level 3 certification.
14. Applicant must not have been a past winner of the WSH Tech Award using the same technology.
15. Applicant must not have been a past applicant or winner for the WSH Innovation Award using the same technology.
16. Applicant must have subscribed to the Ministry of Manpower's [WSH alert service for WSH Incident Reporting](#).

Note: If the implemented WSH solution is an innovation that was customised and developed by both employees and contractors, please apply for the WSH Innovation Awards instead.

¹ Definition of an SME: Either has a group employment of fewer than 200 employees or group annual sales turnover of less than \$100 million

Evaluation

All supporting documents, records and data will be verified and assessed.

Notes for Applicants

1. The applicant's technology will be assessed based on:
 - Innovativeness in the deployment of the technology.
 - Scale of adoption.
 - WSH improvements after implementation.

2. The applicant's technology must be under one of seven categories. The following table lists examples of technologies under each category:

Category	Examples of technology (non-exhaustive)
Robotics or drone-based solutions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Automated guided vehicles (AGVs) in warehouses and distribution centres to transport goods • Robotic arms for hazardous waste handling or working in environments with extreme conditions (e.g. high temperatures, toxic substances) • Collaborative robots that work alongside humans to perform repetitive or dangerous tasks such as lifting heavy objects, assembling parts, handling hazardous materials • Robotic inspection drones • Robotic forklifts in warehouses • Drones for façade cleaning • Drones for façade inspection • Drones for confined space inspections
Video Analytics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Real-time hazard detection systems • Fatigue detection systems • Vision based proximity sensors

Wearables	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Health monitoring wearables that track vitals like heart rate, body temperature and fatigue • Fatigue detection devices to prevent exhaustion-related accidents • Exoskeletons to support physical tasks and reduce strain • Smart helmets with augmented reality (AR) displays to provide safety alerts and real-time data
Sensors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Confined space hazardous gas detection sensors • Worker location tracing • Harness and hook sensors • Mobile elevated working platforms (MEWP) entrapment prevention sensors
Vehicular Safety Technologies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blind spot cameras • Lorry crane stability control system • Advanced driver assistance systems • Driver status monitoring systems • 360° cameras
WSH Management Applications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Electronic Permit to Work • Telematics • Risk assessment tools enhanced with artificial intelligence (AI), e.g. integrating AI system in vehicles/robots to assess and navigate riskier environments • Virtual reality (VR) safety trainings through AI stimulation • Predictive maintenance using AI to predict when equipment will fail, reducing accidents caused by equipment malfunction
Heat Stress prevention solutions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cooling vest • Ice slushies machines • Cooling domes

Disqualification

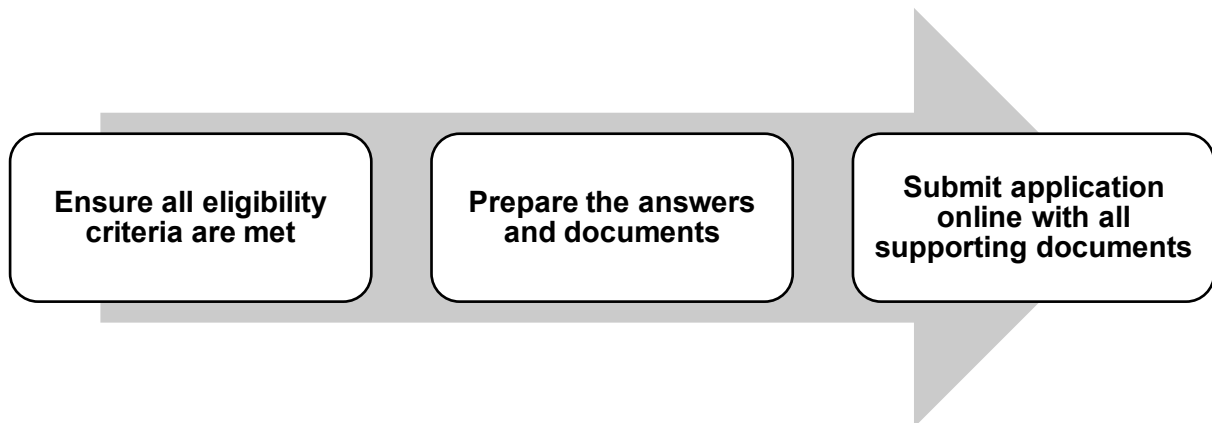
An application may be disqualified if any of the following occurs **before** the announcement of results in **September 2026**:

- a) A [workplace accident](#) resulting in a/ an:
 - Fatal accident;
 - [Major injury](#) accident;
 - Dangerous Occurrence (DO); and/ or
 - Infringement of [legislation under MOM's purview](#).

- b) The application contains inaccurate, false or misleading supporting documents, records or data, or if there is adverse reporting in the media pertaining to the applicant's WSH performance.

- c) An applicant withdraws or amends its [WSH Incident Report](#) and/or an ongoing work injury claim during the period of application. An investigation will be conducted before the application can continue to be considered.

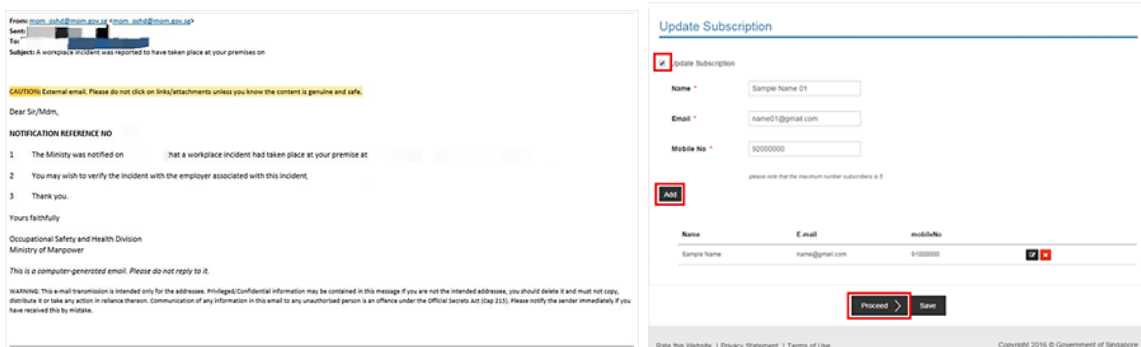
