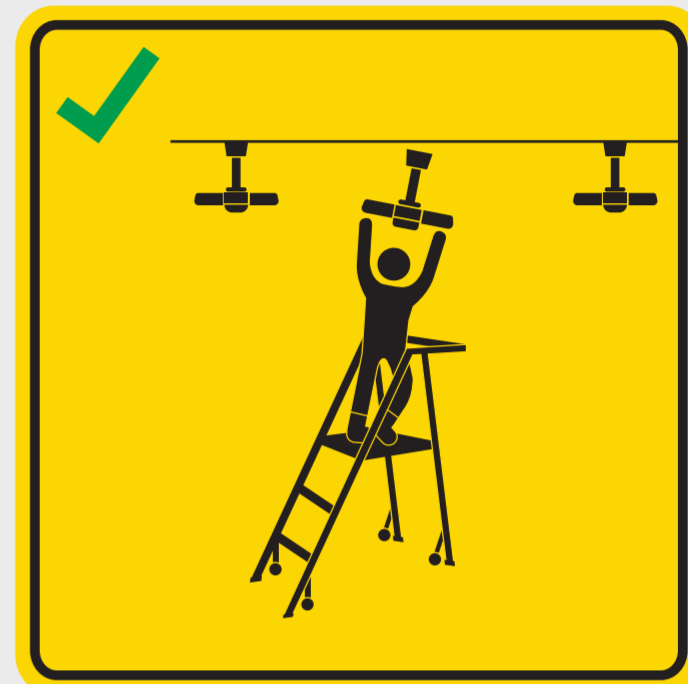
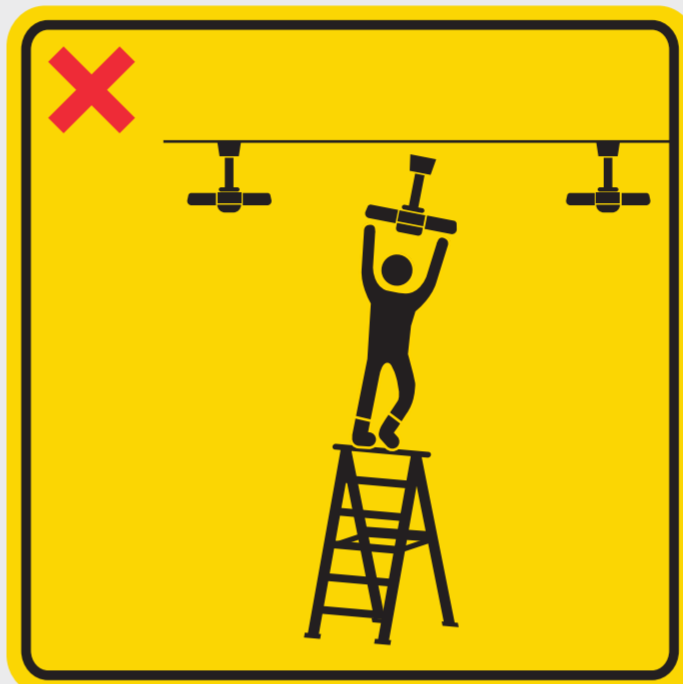
6 Basic Workplace Safety and Health (WSH) Rules for Event Management

In event management, injuries can occur during pre-event construction and post-event dismantling. Common accident types include falling from heights, slips, trips and falls, struck by falling objects as well as musculoskeletal disorders arising from poor ergonomics. Do your risk assessment before starting work.

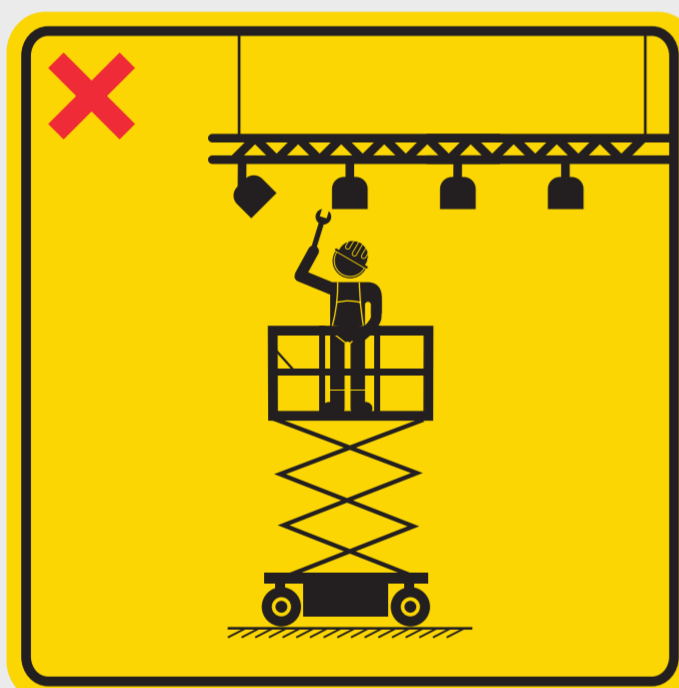
Report to your supervisor if you feel unwell.



Do not stand on the top rung of a ladder. Use a safer option.



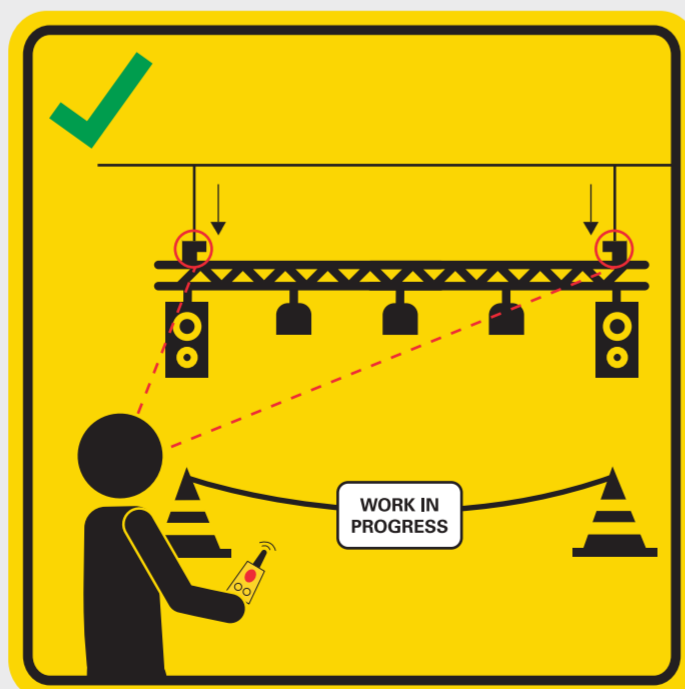
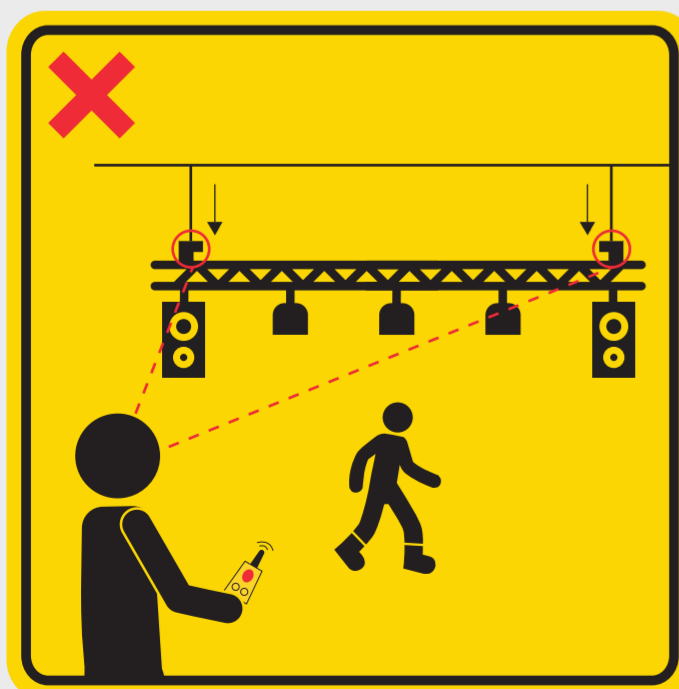
Anchor your harness when working at heights.



Look out for tripping hazards. Cover floor wiring with cable trench.



Never suspend a load over any person. Demarcate lifting zones.



Use a trolley to transport heavy goods.
