LOOK. THINK. DO. Look out for danger. Think of how you can protect yourself. Do your work safely.

Basic Workplace Safety and Health (WSH) Rules for Loading on Vehicles

The consequences of unsafe loading practices can be hazardous and even fatal. **Every year, 6 workers die from unsafe loading and unloading practices**. Do your risk assessment before starting work.

Report to your supervisor if you feel unwell.



Use handbrake and wheel chocks when parking.



Fully extend all lorry crane outriggers on firm level ground.

Stay clear of suspended loads.









Do not stack cargo higher than the headboard.



Lash and secure load properly.
