



6 Basic Workplace Safety and Health (WSH) Rules for Safe Use of MEWPs

Mobile Elevating Work Platforms (MEWPs) are mobile machines with an extendable work platform intended to raise personnel to perform works at height. Unsafe use of MEWPs can result in accidents such as entrapment, toppling and falling from heights, leading to serious injuries and even fatalities. Do a Risk Assessment before starting work involving MEWPs.

Be trained, familiarised and authorised before operating any MEWPs.



Ensure that ground conditions are suitable as required by the specific MEWPs.



Do not exceed the Safe Working Load and maximum number of occupants.



Anchor the harness to the designated anchor point when working on MEWPs.



Maintain a safe distance from overhead obstacles.



Maintain firm footing when working on MEWPs.



Always refer to the manufacturer's manual for the specific MEWP model before starting work. For more information, refer to SS 616: Code of Practice for safe use of mobile elevating work platforms.
