1	<p>How different are your demonstrated software from Slido as part of the interaction with students on PPT? Using slido requires no further software to be installed or further skills required... so, what's the plus points?</p> <p>Mr. Jonta Koga: It depends if you are using Slido as an additional platform on top of showcasing slides via Ms. Powerpoint or integrating all slides on Slido itself. For the latter, there is effectively no major difference between Slido and the 2 platforms demonstrated under Scenario 1 and 2. Advisable to integrate the slide deck to Slido or other platform, so there is one less potential failure point</p>
2	<p>Does IAL provide training course or certification on the software demonstrated?</p> <p>Mr. Jonta Koga: IAL has a catalogue of courses for public-run. Some of the courses do train and certify learners on the use of specific learning technology demonstrated during the webinar. Search 'IAL CPD' for the listing of such upskilling courses.</p> <p>IAL also runs custom, ad-hoc courses that zoom/customise to the requirement specific of the learners. Another potential, cost-effective scenario is for WSHC to pool together interested learners from different TPs and IAL can schedule a bite-sized upskilling course based on the learning technology that the majority are interested in, contextualized for WSH-related TP&gt;</p>

2	<p>For InnovBite, we noted that IAL had curated learntech tools. Are these tools available for TPs (TAEs - Training and Adult Education industry) to adopt and/ or use?</p> <p>Mr. Ivan Lee: Yes, the curation is mainly a listing of software we had tried and tested on our own. TP would need to subscribe on their own to those platform, either for free or at certain subscription. IAL does not provide temporary licence or trial licence on the software listed</p>
3	<p>InnoDev - do you recommend company staff to have prior knowledge / experience in course design or DACE qualification?</p> <p>Mr. Ivan Lee: No requirement to have DACE qualification. Company staff do not need to have prior knowledge/ experience in enabling blended learning, but must have subject matter expertise, deep awareness of courses' target awareness and experience in enabling/ delivering training</p>
4	<p>Will this grant be extended to freelance trainers and programme developers?</p> <p>Mr. Ivan Lee: For innovDev and innovPlus, IAL receives entries to our grant scheme as application from company (ACRA registration evidence is required). For innovJam, we are happy to accept applicants from individuals</p>

1	<p>With the revised RMCP, are there ways to cover these new items effectively and yet stay within the course duration?</p> <p>Mr. Seet Choh San: Use the Hazard Identification, Risk Evaluation and Risk Control as a basis to contextualize the discussion</p>
2	<p>In many workplaces, they review RAs only when they have reportable accidents or dangerous occurrence based on previous WSH (Incident Reporting) Regulations. What about those 1 to 3 days MC?</p> <p>Mr. Seet Choh San: The regulatory requirement to review RA should be considered against corresponding prevailing regulations. The RM Regulations should be referenced to the latest Incident Reporting (Amendment) Regulations 2020</p>
3	<p>With the implementation of the revised RMCP, are we expected to spend more time to explain and elaborate on the new items?</p> <p>Mr. Seet Choh San: Use the Hazard Identification, Risk Evaluation and Risk Control as a useful basis to contextualize the discussion</p>
