OVERVIEW OF SITUATION:

- Noticed a rise in incidences since 2018 2019
- Structured framework was established
- Framework consists the following:
 - Training for staff
 - Collaborative training with security team
 - Identified personnels to activate for incident
 - Debriefing affected staff
- Identify issues and limitations of framework post implementation
- Enhancements to protocols



LIMITATIONS:

- Workflow for escalation relies heavily on surrounding staff to activate
- As most incidents were unreported, management is thus unable to accurately assess the situation
 - Only reported when there is a staff injury or when situation escalates and involvement of police is needed
 - Proposed response actions tied to Stamp score
- Staff do not have a common language or scoring tool to use to identify potential aggressive patients



ENHANCEMENT OF PROTOCOL:

- Introduction of Early identification tool (STAMP Assessment) in 2022
 - Staring, tone and volume of voice, anxiety, mumbling, pacing
 - Easy visual tool for any staff to use
 - Proposed response actions tied to Stamp score
- Ensure accurate reporting of incidents via Risk Management System
 - All cases of abuse must be reported (Verbal / Physical)
 - Provides opportunity to view the issues and improve protocols to ensure safety



TAKE HOME MESSAGE:

- Violent, abusive and aggressive behaviours towards healthcare workers are not tolerated
- Do not hesitate to take appropriate actions against those who do so
- Everyone deserves to work in a safe environment while we care for patients
- Safety protocols needs to be reviewed periodically and enhanced as necessary
