Definitions

- Slips Falling on the same level due to loss of balance when there is too little friction between the foot and the floor. For example, when stepping on a wet or oily surface.
- Trips Falling on the same level due to loss of balance when:
 - the **foot** collides with, strikes or hits an object in its path; or
 - one steps down **unexpectedly** from a higher to a lower surface (misstep).
- Falls A downward movement, typically rapidly and freely,
 from a higher to a lower level.

Why the need to prevent Slips, Trips and Falls?

- STFs one of the **top cause** of workplace deaths and among the most common cause of workplace injuries
- Can cause sprains, strains, fractures, head injuries and deaths






Why the need to prevent Slips, Trips and Falls?








Pay attention when walking






Keep walkways well-lit and free of obstructions
