Join us for the Diving Safety Seminar 2021 on 17 September 2021

The Commercial Diving Association (Singapore), with the support of the Workplace Safety and Health (WSH) Council and Shipbuilding & Marine Engineering Employees Union, is organising the annual Diving Safety Seminar on 17 September 2021. Due to prevailing COVID-19 restrictions, this year's seminar will be conducted virtually.

Senior Minister of State, Ministry of Manpower, Mr Zaqy Mohamad, will be delivering the opening remarks live. This seminar will launch the revised WSH Guidelines on Inland/Inshore Commercial Diving, previously known as the Technical Advisory on Inland/Inshore Commercial Diving Safety and Health. Speakers from the Ministry of Manpower, the WSH Council and the commercial diving industry, will be sharing on relevant topics in commercial diving safety, including recent inspection findings related to diving activities.

Slips, Trips and Falls (STFs) have been the top cause of both major and minor injuries in workplaces since 2012. The number of STF-related injuries had increased by 15% from 2015 to 2020.

Companies can co-create safe workplaces by working together with their employees to set and fulfil an STF resolution to take time to check, clean and share good practices to minimise or eliminate STF hazards.

Accidents can occur when accessing or using workspaces, when getting up or down the steps, when walking up or down the slopes, or when one is distracted or tired. It is important to train your workers to identify STF hazards so that they can take actions to keep themselves safe.

Look out for these STF hazards in the workplace:

- Slippery areas
- Slopes

- Uneven areas
- Cluttered areas
