With effect from 1 November 2022, experiential learning will be introduced as part of the training curriculum for this course for all new and existing construction workers who fail their recertification tests.

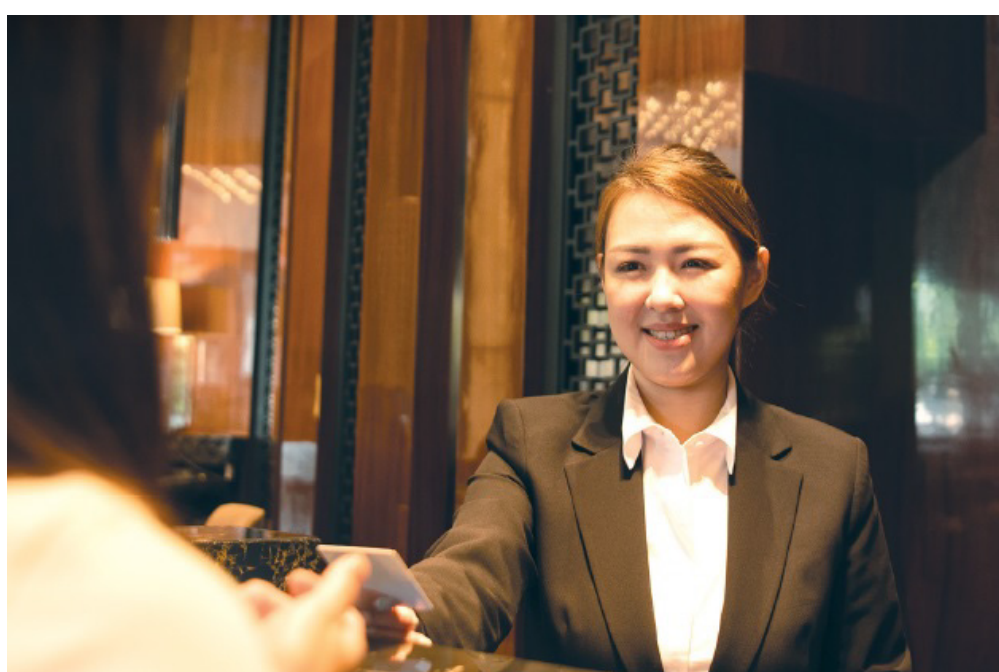
