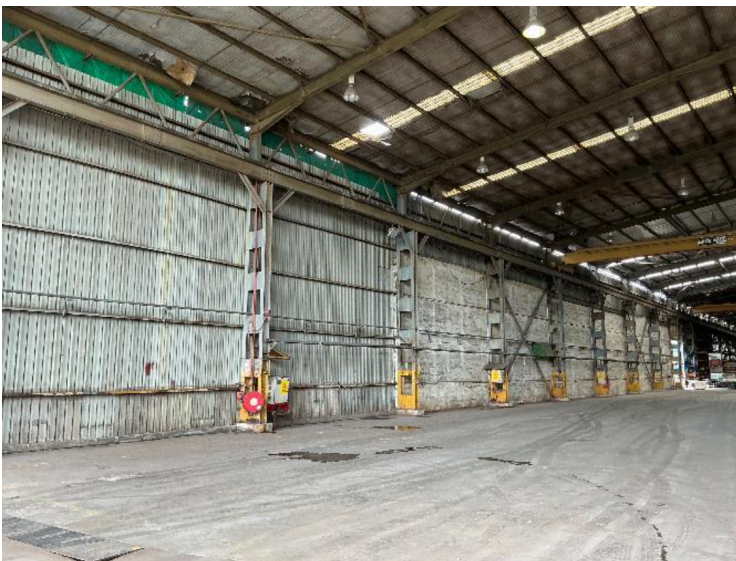
WSH Advisory for Fatal Accidents in Second Half of 2025 ^{[1][2]}

In the second half of 2025, there were 19 workplace fatalities, including three work-related traffic accidents. Of the remaining 16 fatalities, four had been previously reported on [16 January](#) and [27 January](#).

This advisory covers 11 workplace fatalities, grouped into four incident categories. It highlights the risks involved and provides recommendations to help companies prevent similar accidents from recurring.

^[1] In 2025, there were a total of 36 fatalities, including 6 Work-related Traffic Accidents (WRTA).

^[2] In the first half of 2025, there were 17 fatalities reported, including 3 Work-related Traffic Accidents (WRTA), released on [30 September](#).



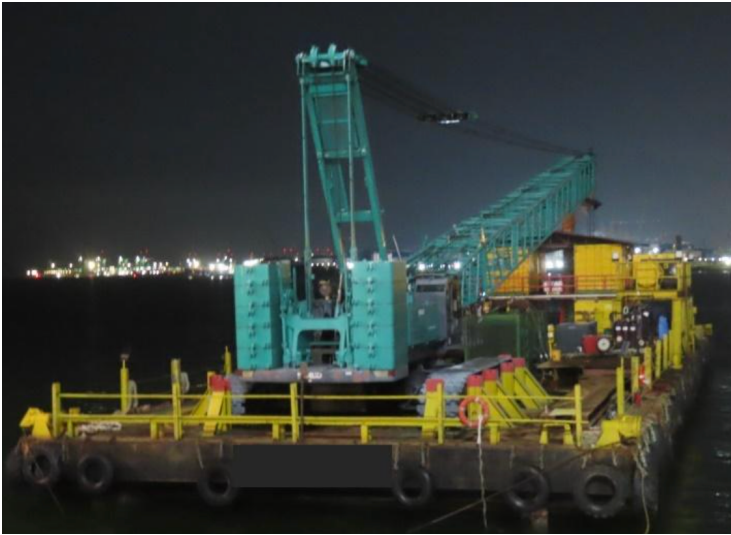
