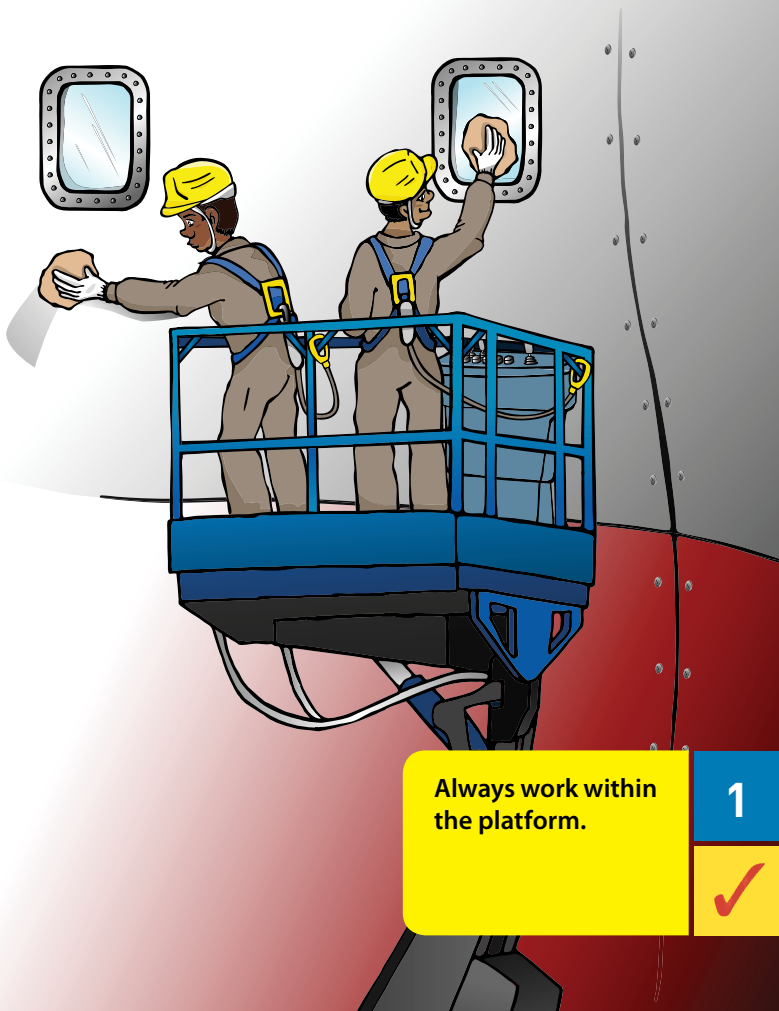

Always check the "OK/Safe For Use Tag" on scaffolding before use.

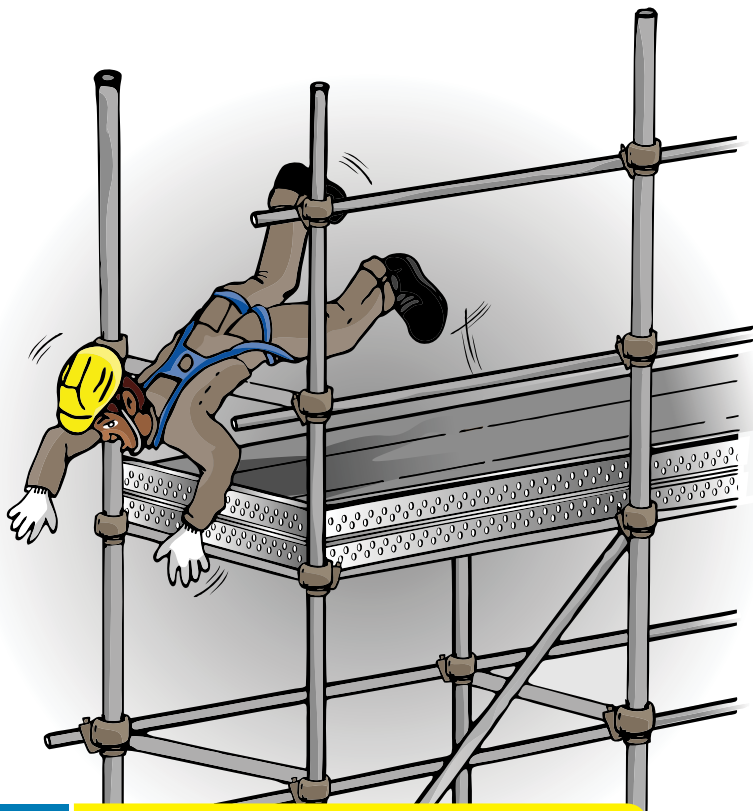




**Wear your safety harness

Check that scaffolds are tagged and certified safe by Scaffold Supervisor before use.

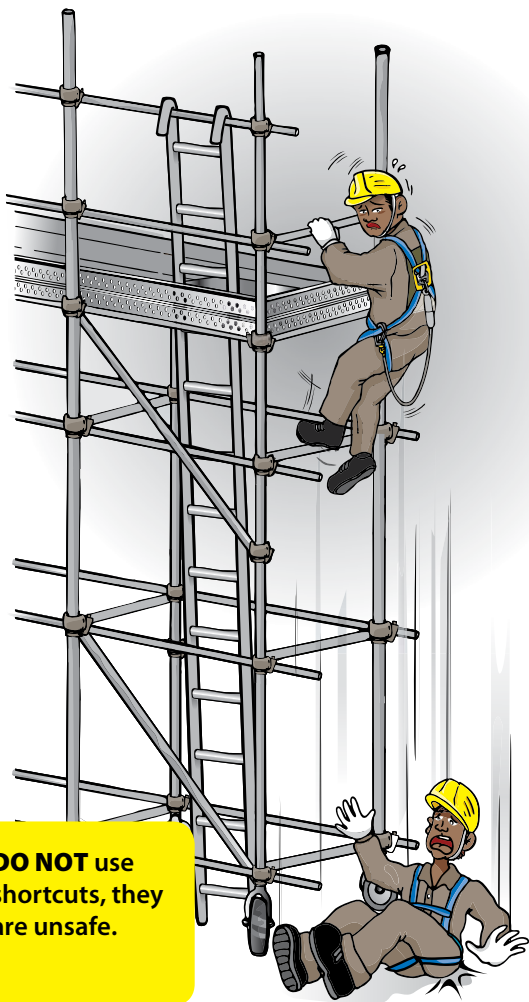




Floor openings

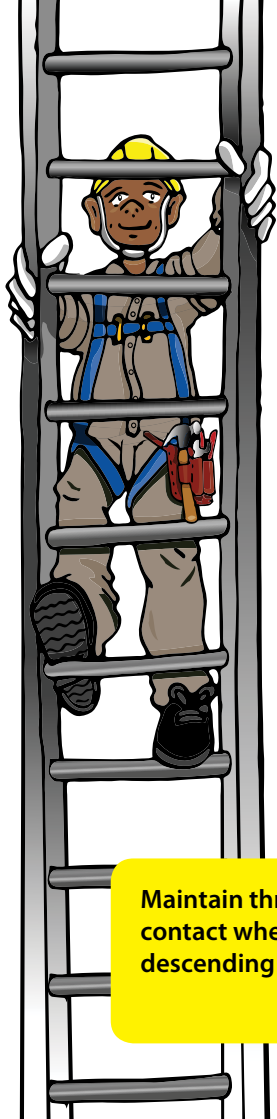

are unsafe.

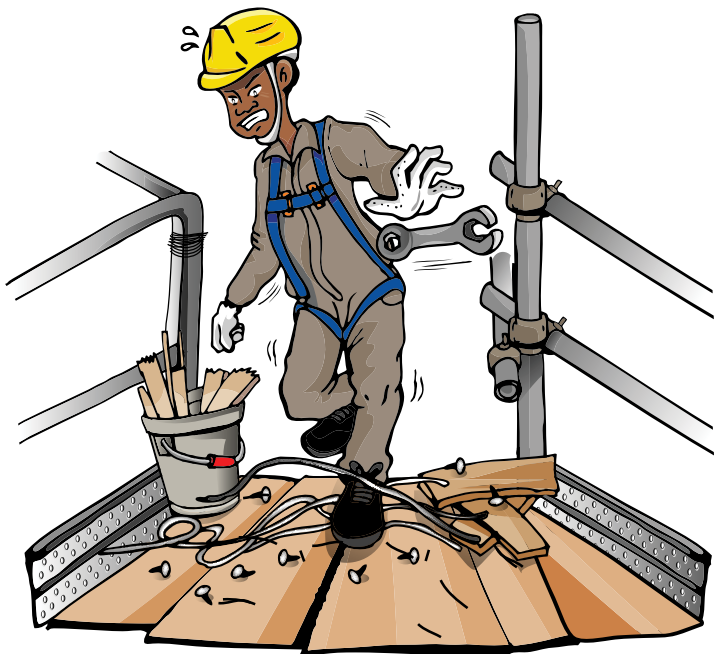




Maintain three points of contact when climbing/ descending a ladder.

housekeeping.

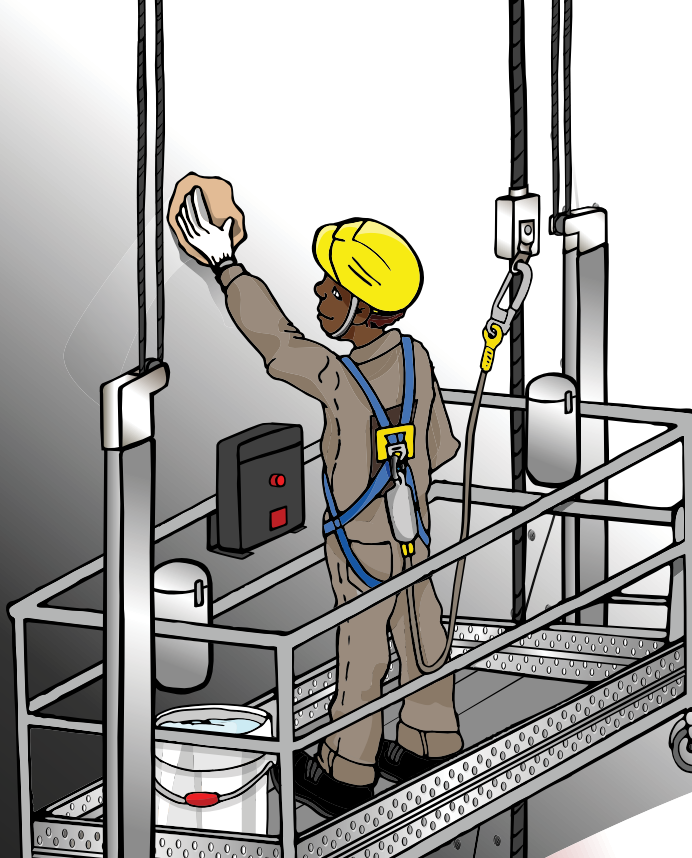




DO NOT use forklift to reach higher areas.

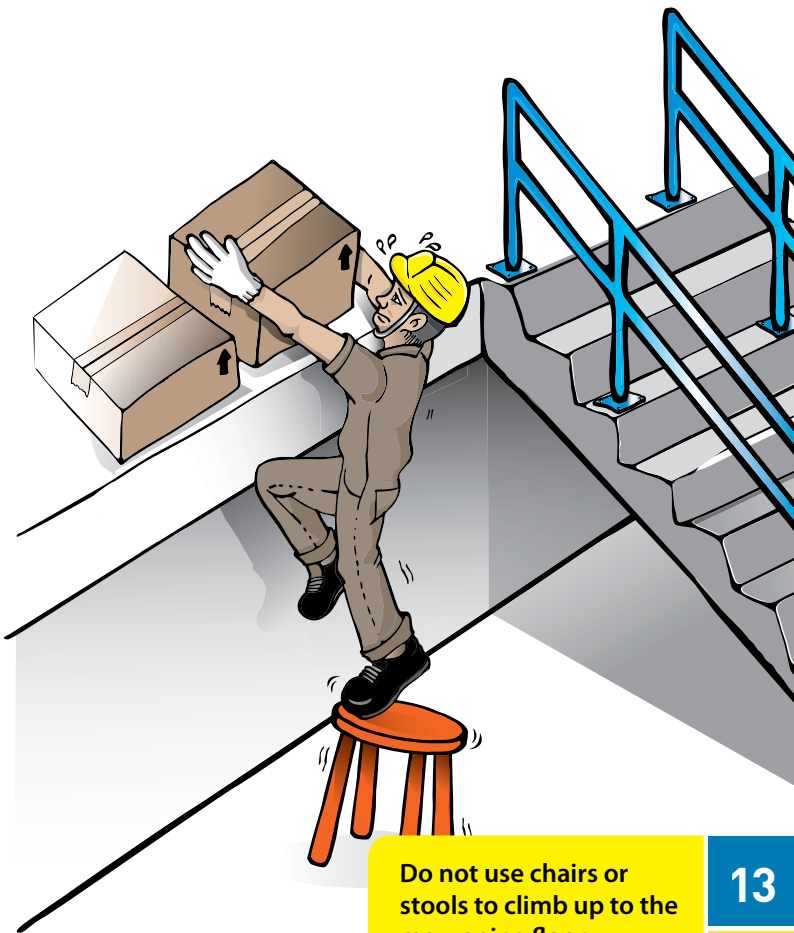
